7,139 Indian prisoners lodged in foreign jails: MEA

NEW DELHI: A total of 7,139 Indian prisoners, including undertrials, are lodged in various jails around the world, the Ministry of External Affairs said on Thursday. Saudi Arabia has the highest number of 1,599 Indian prisoners, followed by the United Arab Emirates with 898 and Nepal

having 886 inmates, according to information provided by Minister of State for External Affairs V Muralidharan in Rajya Sabha. "As per the information available with the ministry, the number of Indian prisoners in foreign jails as on December 31, 2020, is 7,139, which also includes undertrials," he said.

YOU ARE NOT ALONE, PRIYANKA TELLS FARMERS

Cong general secretary meets family of a farmer who lost his life during protest in New Delhi on R-Day

Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Thursday drove down to Rampur town in Uttar Pradesh and met mother, father and grand father of Navneet Singh, who died in ITO in Delhi during the Republic Day protests, sharing their concern that he was shot in head by police while driving a tractor that overturned killing him.

After attending a prayer meeting for Navneet at Dibdiba village, Priyanka told a small gathering that if the citizens tolerate crimes by police, it is a bigger sin than a crime. She also slammed those branding the farmers as 'terrorist laws'.

She quoted Sikhs' Guru Gobind Singh that "committing a crime is a sin, but to tol-

erate crime is a greater sin." "If a leader can't listen to the pain of our nation's farmers, poor or any citizen and instead chooses to call them names, then that leader is of no use," she said.

Assuring the family that her party stands with them, Priyanka told the family members that "sacrifice of their young son will not go waste and the government will have to repeal anti-farmer farm laws." She alleged that by not withdrawing farm laws the government was doing injustice to farmers.

"You are not alone but the entire country is with you. The govt calls farmers terrorists and their agitation a political conspiracy. They are perpetuating a crime against farmers by not understanding their problems and pain," she said, addressing public gathered there

NEW DELHI: Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh-affiliate Bharatiya Kisan Sangh (BKS) on Thursday said that it will not support farmer unions 'chakka jam' call given for February 6 for blocking national and state highways for three hours.

Farmer unions have said that they will block the highways in protest against the internet ban in areas near their agitation sites, harassment allegedly meted out to them by authorities, and against three farm laws.

"Now, the protest at all the borders of Delhi is very much political and it is clearly visible that this has become political propaganda," BKS General Secretary Badri Narayan Choudhary told ANI. "Earlier the Canadian political leaders supported the farmers' protests, then British leaders and now celebrities from other countries. It proves that this is propaganda against India and they will damage the peace and harmony of the country," he said.

4.5 mn vaccinated in 19 days: Govt

While hearing a petition seeking inclusion of judges and advocates in the first phase of the Covid vaccination drive in the country, the Delhi High Court on Thursday said that it sees no reason to change the priorities set by the Central government.

"The government aims to vaccinate nearly 30 crore people in the first phase, which includes three crore healthcare and frontline workers and 27 crore elderly people, mostly above the age of 50 years with comorbidities such as diabetes, heart or liver ailments.

"The government has its own priorities and we do not see any reason to change the priority for vaccination," said a bench comprising Chief Justice D.N. Patel and Justice Jyoti Singh said.

The bench, however, directed the Central government and the Unique Identification Authority of India to consider the petition filed by Amrendra Singh, a practicing lawyer, as a representation.

The petition had stated that several advocates faced unprecedented times due to the outbreak of the pandemic and they are still dealing with the repercussions of the same.

NEW DELHI: Nearly 4.5 million (44,49,552) beneficiaries have received COVID-19 vaccine shots in merely 19 days, the Union Health Ministry said on Thursday.

India became the fastest country in the world to reach the 4 million COVID-19 vaccination mark, achieving this feat in 18 days.

"Many other countries have had a head start of almost 65 days. India launched the countrywide COVID-19 vaccination drive on January 16. The number of beneficiaries being vaccinated every day has also shown a progressive increase," the ministry said.

Active Covid cases down to 1.55 lakh

NEW DELHI: The active cases of Covid-19 further dropped to 1.55 lakh on Thursday, which is 1.44% of the total infections of 1.08 crore while the recovery also shot up to 97.13% as 1.05 cr have recovered, 17,824 of them in the past 24 hours. There were a total of 107 deaths in 24 hours, 30 of them in Maharashtra and 20 in Kerala while they were in a single digit in case of 20 of the 35 states/UTs. Cumulative deaths in the country are 1,54,703.

IAF to get 1st batch of Tejas by March 2024

R Madhavan, Chairman and Managing Director of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL), on Thursday, said that they will deliver Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas to Indian Air Force (IAF) by March 2024.

"As per the contract, we are to start delivery of LCA (Light Combat Aircraft) by 36 months from today. The first delivery will be by March 2024. In the first year, there will be delivery of two aircraft which will be ramped up to 16. Total supply time, post first delivery is 6 years," Madhavan said at a press conference in Bengaluru.

"We faced issues due to lockdown in the first two quarters. The first quarter was completely washed out.

HAL to launch unmanned fighter jet

BENGALURU: Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) on Thursday unveiled a leap in technology of teaming up unmanned aircraft and vehicles with manned jets similar to the US project of skybrog. It will enhance Indian military strike capabilities. Teamed with a manned aircraft known as mother-ship, the unmanned aircraft will leverage autonomy to disrupt and defeat adversaries in contested environments. The technology named Combined Air Teaming System (CATS) will have a mother ship, operating from faraway, and four autonomous unmanned aerial vehicle known as CATS Warrior with a capacity to carry out strike stealthily entering 700 kilometres inside enemy territory.

But till the third quarter, we recovered. So financially or otherwise, we will reach the target set for the year, as per pre-Covid times," he added.

Meanwhile, the IAF sought quotation from the HAL to make its basic Hindustan Turbo Trainer (HTT-40) for training its pilots, a top official said on Thursday.

'India has potential for reliable arms supplier'

India has chartered a plan to build defence partnerships with nations on the Indian Ocean rim while strengthening ties with immediate neighbours. Participating in a series of seminars and conclaves in connection with on-going Aero India 2021 here, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said: "India has a vast coastline but our interests are beyond our shores, touching various continents, especially in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR). Whether it is piracy, security, disasters or any other need, India has always offered assistance and we want to be a reliable partner, in line with Prime Minister Modi's SAGAR (Security and Growth for All in the Region) initiative," Singh said Wednesday. The plan has gained strength with India's growing defence capabilities.



"The domestic defence market is growing. We've earmarked \$130 bn for military modernisation for the next eight years. The defence sector has been opened up and we encourage foreign OEMs to collaborate with Indian firms," he said. "A high-level committee has been formed to expedite clearances needed for exports. India has the potential to become a reliable supplier of defence equipment and there are 5,000 MSMEs in the sector apart from one of the fastest-growing startup ecosystems," the Defence Minister said.

Gandhi forgotten, says Congress

NEW DELHI: In a series of tweets, the Congress on Thursday regretted that Mahatma Gandhi's ideals seem to have been forgotten and recalled its political heritage.

"Today the love of power has overcome the power of love and Gandhi's India is being destroyed," it tweeted, saying that "in the story of the 'Quit India Movement' lies a great lesson for Indians today: united, we can defeat tyranny.

Even as Delhi Police started removing nails from the roads at Delhi's entry points after a global criticism of preventing people come to the national capital, Congress tweeted on "the last nail in the coffin of British rule in India" in the year 1942.

"This is the story of the movement and the revolution which ultimately set the sun on the British empire," it said. In another tweet, the party declared: "We will not allow fascism & despotism to rule India - not today, not ever." —Our Bureau

On the basis of this complaint, a case under 124A, 153A, 153B (1) (C), 295A, 298, 504, 505 (1) (B) and 505 (2) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and IT Act has been registered, police said.

10 airports to be privatised in 3rd round

NEW DELHI: The government on Thursday announced that a maximum of ten airports will be privatised in the third round of airport privatisation. "In the third round (of airport privatisation) six to ten airports are going to be privatised," Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) Secretary Pradeep Singh Kharola told media here. "The Airports Authority of India is examining the possibility of selling loss-making airports along with a profitable one. AAI is examining the possibility of giving non-profitable airport and profit-making airports as a package. The airports will be given to the private sector," Kharola said.

Change of Guard ceremony to resume

NEW DELHI: The Change of Guard ceremony, which was discontinued due to COVID-19, will resume from this Saturday at the Rashtrapati Bhavan, according to an official communique issued on Thursday. The ceremony will take place on every Saturday (except on government holidays), it said. "On every Saturday, a maximum 100 people will be allowed to witness the ceremony with prior booking," said the statement issued by the Rashtrapati Bhavan. Booking can be made online by visiting website <https://presidentofindia.nic.in> or <https://rashtrapatisachivalaya.gov.in/>, it said.

Lady lawyer throws ink at Kannada writer

BENGALURU: In a fit of rage, a woman lawyer splashed ink on rationalist and multiple award-winning Kannada writer KS Bhagwan on Thursday at a Bengaluru court. Soon after the incident, a video of the incident was shared on Facebook and Twitter by lawyer Meera Raghavendra who claimed that she threw ink as a form of punishment. According to Meera, Bhagwan deserved this for allegedly insulting Hindu religion. As she threw ink on Bhagwan, other lawyers tried to protect him even as Meera was heard shouting that "she is ready to do anything" or even go to jail if required for doing this. "You are a professor and so old, yet you continue to speak trash about Hinduism and the Gods. Are you not ashamed of yourself," she told Bhagwan.

The atheist-writer was at the court seeking bail in connection with a case. Bhagwan has often attracted controversy and has been targeted by the BJP and fringe Hindu right organisations. —Shankar Raj

Two Delhi sisters claim Ayodhya mosque land

Ten days after foundation laying ceremony of Dhannipur mosque in Ayodhya, two Delhi-based sisters have claimed the ownership of 5 acres of mosque land challenging the allotment at the Lucknow bench of the Allahabad High Court.

Five acres of land was allotted to the Central Sunni Waqf Board by the Yogi Adityanath government at Dhannipur and Raunahi villages in Ayodhya for the construction of the mosque on the directions of the Supreme Court.

Rani Kapoor alias Rani Baluja and her sister Rama Rani Punjabi claimed in the petition that their father Gyan Chandra Punjabi was allotted 28 acres of land in village Dhannipur by the Nazul department for five year lease when he came to India after partition in 1947 and settled in Faizabad (now Ayodhya).

They further claimed that his name was recorded in revenue records and he continued to have possession of the land even after expiry of the lease. The 5 acres land allotted to the Central Sunni Waqf Board by the state government on the directions of the Supreme Court in village

Dhannipur is part of that 28 acres land owned by their father, said the two sisters in the petition.

They prayed in the petition to cancel the allotment of 5 acres of land to Central Sunni Waqf Board as they are the real owners of the allotted land.

The petition by the two sisters is likely to come up for hearing on February 8. The Indo-Islamic Cultural Foundation (IICF), entrusted with the task of constructing the mosque on the allotted land, has already laid foundation stone of the mosque on the Republic Day on January 26.

"We have nothing to do with this petition. The matter is between the petitioners, state government and local administration who identified and allotted this 5 acres of land in Village Dhannipur and Raunahi in Ayodhya to the Board on the directions of the honourable Supreme Court," the IICF Secretary Athar Husain told the FPJ.

Sources, however, claim that the petition by the two sisters may cause unnecessary delay in the construction of the mosque, depending on how the proceedings go on at the Lucknow High Court in the case.

China conveys clearance on transfer of ship crew: MEA

After a sustained follow-up by the Indian embassy in Beijing, China has conveyed their clearance on transfer of the crew of cargo ship MV Anastasia, said the Ministry of External Affairs on Thursday.

MV Anastasia, which has 16 Indian nationals is on anchorage near the Caofeidian port in China since September 20 due to coronavirus-related restrictions.

"After a sustained follow up by Indian embassy in Beijing, the Chinese central authorities have conveyed their clearance to the local foreign office in Tangshan and to the port authorities, for the

transfer of the crew of MV Anastasia," MEA spokesperson Anurag Srivastava said during the weekly virtual press conference.

"This information has also been shared with the shipping company, and we understand it has submitted the request to the concerned authorities. We hope that crew change is effected at the earliest," he said.

Earlier, Anurag Srivastava said, "Cargo vessel MV Jagannath is on anchorage near Jingtang port in China since June 13 and has 23 Indian nationals on board. Another vessel, MV Anastasia, which has 16 Indian nationals is on anchorage near the Caofeidian port in China since September 20.
